NOTES ON SYNOD PROCEDURES

The following notes are provided for the guidance of members of the Synod:

- Due to the extraordinary circumstances giving rise to Synod being conducted on-line via video-conferencing (Zoom) all Elections, Motions and Legislation will be deferred to the Third Session of this Synod 2021, scheduled for May 2021.
- The usual protocols for speaking through the President are made more difficult by virtue of using Zoom. Members are requested to:
 - Place themselves on 'Mute' when not speaking;
 - Raise their hand when wishing to speak, and
 - Wait for the President to invite that member to speak.
- Members are requested to 'rename' themselves via the Zoom portal to record the names of persons attending Synod in the one location in order for the attendance record to be taken. Please refer to Attachment A of these papers providing guidance as to how to change a Zoom participants name.
- Members are not required to rise to speak, and may direct their address, question or comment to the President or the presenter of a report to Synod.

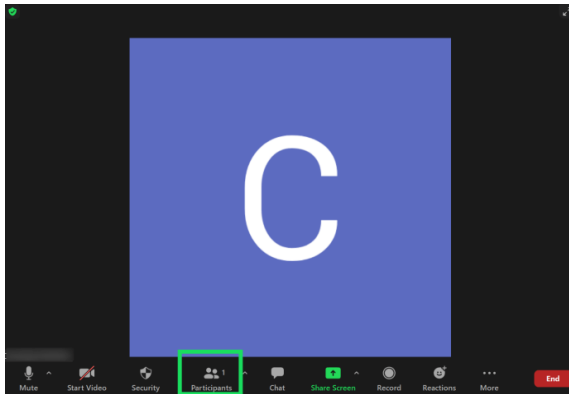

ATTACHMENT A: Changing your Name Inside a Zoom Room

Once you have joined a Zoom session, you or any other participant can change your displayed name. Here's how to do it:

Step 1

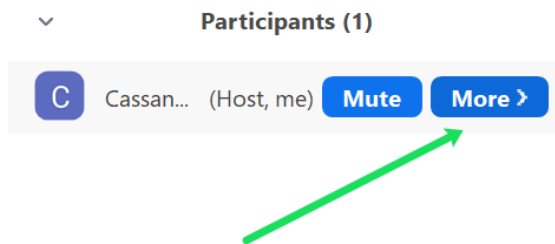
Click on the Participants icon at the bottom of the Zoom Room window. This will take you to a meeting menu featuring the topic, host, invitation, and participant information.



There are also clickable thumbnails to Share Screen, Join Audio, or Invite Others. The 'Participants' pop-up automatically appears allowing for more actions.

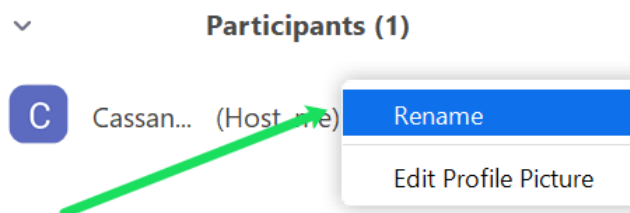
Step 2

Hover over your name in the 'Participants' pane (a pop-out one the right of Zoom's interface) and click 'More.'



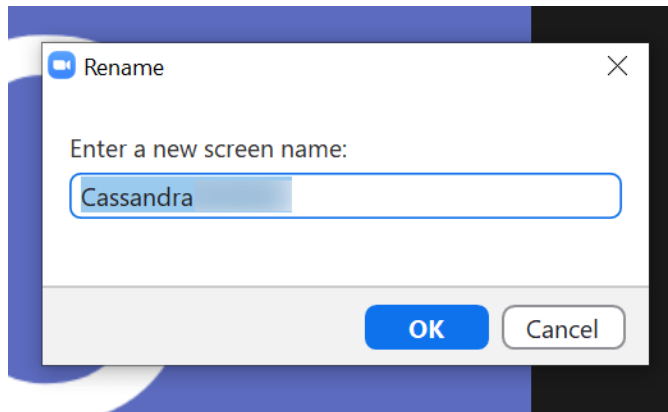
Step 3

Click on Rename to update your in-room display name.



Step 4

Another box will pop up and you type in the preferred name in the “Enter New Name” box. Once you’re done click OK and your new name should appear within the app.



The same pop-up features the “Remember my name for future meetings” option. Feel free to check the box in front of it to save the settings.
